Extending Invitations to Girl Scouts of the USA Procedures

Start planning at least four months in advance.

- 1.** The Guider wishing to extend the invitation obtains three copies of this form from her Area International Adviser.
- 2.** The Guider completes, signs and sends all three copies to her immediate Commissioner.
- 3.** The Commissioner, if she approves, signs all three copies and forwards them to the Provincial International Director. At the same time, she informs the Area International Adviser of the application.
- 4.** The Provincial International Director, if she approves, returns one signed copy to the Guider indicating approval has been given, and forwards one signed copy to GSUSA.
- 5.** GSUSA writes directly to the person who submitted the application, indicating whether or not the invitation can be accepted and giving the name and address of the person in the USA with whom she can correspond and plan. A copy of this letter is sent to the Provincial International Director.
- 6.** From this point on, the negotiations proceed between the person extending the invitation and her GSUSA contact.

Note: Girl Scouts of the USA follow similar procedures for Across-the-Border invitations to the Girl Guides of Canada.
