

Girl Guides of Canada, Newfoundland and Labrador Council, New Unit Start Up Fund

Fund purpose: To provide financial assistance to new units registered under Newfoundland and Labrador Council

Eligibility: New unit with no previous unit activity. Units closed for no less than one guiding year and reopened.

Application: May be obtained from www.girlguides.ca/nl. Request for assistance must be submitted to the Newfoundland and Labrador Council office. Recordkeeping and accounting for new unit usage shall be in accordance with the financial standards of GGC. Financial records for all amounts paid for new unit start up funds must be sent to the designated council within 30 days of payment.

Funds: Once an application is approved, a new unit is eligible to receive up to maximum of \$100 to assist with new unit start up expenses. The unit will submit receipts to show purchases for new unit. The unit will remit receipts until the funds are used. It is important that receipts are submitted to the provincial office by the end of each month.

Other considerations: New units must have a registered unit treasurer and be set up with a Unified Banking account.
